a. Bondage *Exod. 1:1-7:7 (Cont.)*

(5) Moses Returns to Egypt *4:19-7:7*

(a) Mission restated.

(i) Performs wonders even though Pharaoh's heart is hardened.

(ii) Forewarn Pharaoh – death to his first-born.

(b) Enroute encounter with God.

(c) Aaron meets with Moses.

(d) Confrontation with Pharaoh.

b. Wonders – The Ten Plagues *Exod. 7:8-12:36.*

(1)	Water to Blood	<i>7:8-24</i>	River God	Pharaoh's heart hardened.
(2)	Frogs	<i>8:1-15</i>	Goddess Hect	Pharaoh's heart hardened.
(3)	Lice	<i>8:16-19</i>	Earth god Seb	Finger of God. Pharaoh's heart hardened.
(4)	Beetles (Flies)	<i>8:20-32</i>	Scarab	Go, but stay in the land.
(5)	Murrain of Cattle	<i>9:1-7</i>	Apis, Bull	Pharaoh's heart hardened.
(6)	Boils on Man & Beast	<i>9:8-12</i>	Typhon	Pharaoh's heart hardened.
(7)	Hail and Fire	<i>9:13-35</i>	Shew (air)	Pharaoh's heart hardened.
(8)	Locust	<i>10:1-20</i>	Serapia	Go, but leave sons and daughters.
(9)	Darkness	<i>10:21-29</i>	Sun god Ra	Go, but leave flocks and herd.
(10)	Death to First-Born	<i>11:1-12:36</i>	Pharaoh	Go. Bless Me. Passover. Unleavened bread.
