          - Army routed, 36 die.
          - Sin purged from Camp.
- NOTE: Sin in the Camp.
- Can exist and leaders not be aware of it.
  - Involves more than sinner.
  - Means it is time for action not prayer.
  - Causes "Body" not to be able to stand before enemy.
  - Needs to be made known to whole congregation.
  - Caused by "I saw; I coveted; I took; I hid".
  - When purged, brings God's blessings again.
